CHILDREN'S Financial Assistance

Program Policy

Mission: To provide financial assistance for medical and dental care for dependent children of Oregon Master Masons.

Overview: To supplement the financial resources of our members for the benefit of their children through assistance with medical and dental expenses. This assistance may be offered once or on a continuous basis depending on the need and circumstances of the situation. No expectation of repayment will be placed on any family or member for funds awarded by this program.

Eligibility: To qualify, the parent of the child would need to be an Oregon Master Mason with 5+ years of good standing prior to the application for assistance. This includes dependent children from birth through 21 years of age.

To qualify for Financial Assistance, a client must demonstrate a financial need through an income and expenditures analysis, to be completed with an assessment. All other resources; including Medicare, Medicaid, and personal insurance must be exhausted prior to the utilization of financial assistance.

The following services are eligible for financial assistance.

- **Medical equipment** - Defined as respiratory equipment, nutrition therapy, incontinence supplies, assisted therapy devices, and other medically necessary equipment as determined by physician. All requests for medical equipment require prescription and medical pre-authorization.
- **Medical bills** - Defined as medical, therapy, and hospital expenses. Financial need must be demonstrated, and assistance determined necessary by the assessment.
- **Dental Expenses** - Includes orthodontia services. Financial need must be demonstrated, and assistance determined necessary by the assessment.

Payment process: Once eligibility and level of financial need are assessed, assistance is awarded based on predetermined assistance guidelines and annual caps per person. Any requests for funds outside these limits shall be submitted to the Grand Lodge Trustees for approval before funds are disbursed. All payments are made directly to providers; no money is paid to the family.
